Regular Session Sargent Community Center June 11, 2018

The Mayor and Council of the City of Sargent, Nebraska, met in Regular Session at the Sargent Community Center on the 11th day of June 2018, at 7:00 p.m. Notice of the meeting was posted at the City Office, U. S. Post Office, Corner Market and First National Bank on Thursday May 31, 2018.
